The property generated energy savings of 1,301,403 Liters of Oil Equivalent (LOE) valued at P51.54 million and 2,094,211 kg of avoided CO₂ emissions through the efficient management of systems including airconditioning, light and water under the direction of Engr. Lampa, who was named “Outstanding Energy Manager”.

Oakwood Premier Joy~Nostalg Center Manila is designed with low emissivity glass walls that reduce the penetration of outside heat by 30%, further enhancing its energy programme results. As a recipient of the award, it establishes its leadership in the promulgation of environment-friendly practices and affirms its commitment to government efforts to increase productivity through improved energy efficiency.

The Don Emilio Abello Energy Efficiency Awards is an industry-based recognition given to agencies and establishments with outstanding performance in energy conservation and efficiency in government, business and industrial sections.
